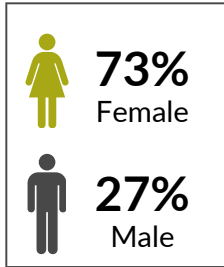


COVID-19 & Latino Communities

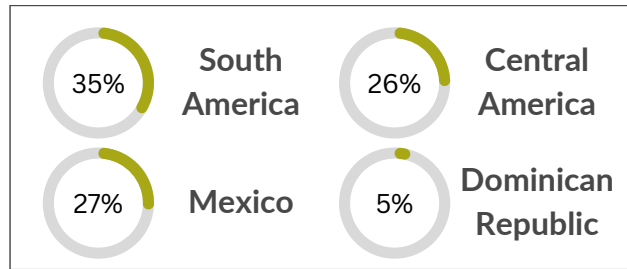

Gender

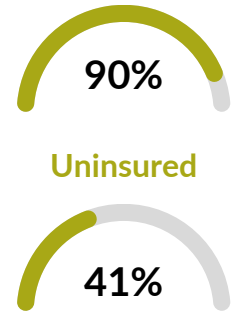


Country of Origin

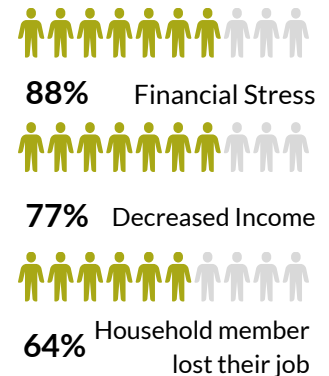
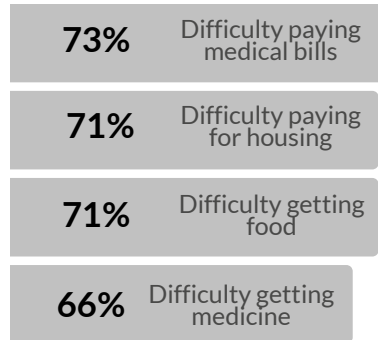
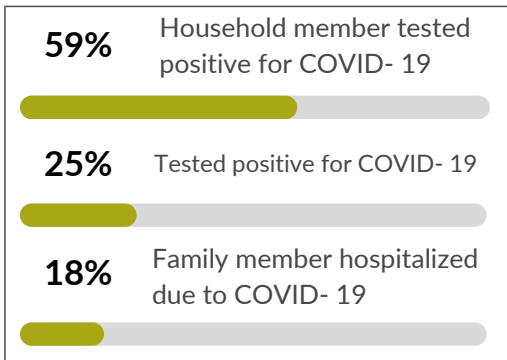

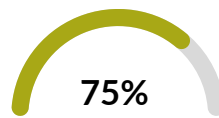
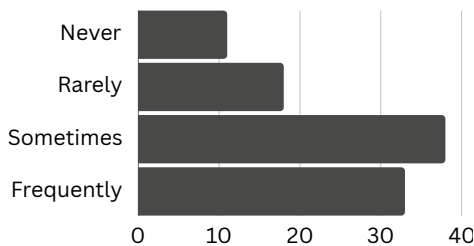
