Camino University provides educational opportunities for both Spanish- and English-speaking communities by removing geographical, linguistic, and financial barriers. Through transformative local and digital classroom experiences, the university equips students with the intellect, ingenuity, and global perspective necessary to become community-oriented leaders.

SCHOOL OF LEADERSHIP

- Enrolled the first cohort in the Community Development track
- 32 Latino pastors are set to complete the City Changers course in May 2025, an eight-month hybrid program focused on strategic faith-based community transformation.
- A second-year leadership curriculum is in development for 2025, designed to further equip Latino leaders for community impact.



SCHOOL OF DIVINITY

- 11 students made up the inaugural cohort of the Certificate in Missional Church Planting Program.
- Offered 4 theological and biblical studies courses (each 20 hours), with 115 students completing coursework in theology, apologetics, biblical studies, and church history.
- In 2025, the school will expand its theological and biblical studies track with 4 additional courses covering the Old and New Testaments, forming a 2-year certificate program in biblical studies.



SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

- Camino University will launch a school of Business in partnership with Camino Arriba to support workforce and economic development.
- Course offerings will include computer literacy, small business development, and English as a Second Language (ESL).
